

## Resolution on the Mediterranean Youth Forum

Adopted by the General Assembly Salzburg, Austria, 1-4 October 1998

Resolution on the Mediterranean Youth Forum adopted as amended by the General Assembly held in Salzburg, Austria, 1-4 October 1998

The European Youth Forum, as Pan-european platform of youth organisations, and as one of the main Mediterranean Youth Forum boosters, remains in its commitment of keeping on advancing in the co-operation and mutual understanding between young people in the Mediterranean, and state through this resolution:

- 1. Its congratulations for the efforts realised in the planning, establishment and follow-up of the setting up process of the Mediterranean Youth Forum, as a concrete example of the YFJ vocation for the co-operation and solidarity with young people from other regions of the world.
- 2. The necessity of opening the MYF, which in this moment involves some countries that signed the Barcelona Declaration, towards a real Pan-Mediterranean space, including in it all the Mediterranean countries without any exclusion. The Mediterranean Youth Forum should be a space for the widest possible representation of youth organisations.
- 3. The necessity of an adequate co-ordinating among the European institutions in the support of the youth co-operation, especially the support provided by the Council of Europe and the European Union, according to the youth organisations necessities and not only attending governmental or institutional criteria.
- 4. The necessity of insisting in the bilateral co-operation at grassroot level, as vital background for the multilateral co-operation frameworks.
- 5. The necessity of giving continuity and reforming the Euro-Arab Youth Dialogue Framework as general space of debate and mutual knowledge, orienting it to the realisation of common projects.
- 6. The urgent necessity of advancing towards the constitution of a real Mediterranean space of Youth Mobility, solving the serious problem of getting visas for youth activities.
